The AK-CESCL (Alaska Certified Erosion and Sediment Control Lead) is a training and certification program to enhance compliance with the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation Construction General Permit for storm water discharges. AK-CESCL offers two trainings; a two-day 16 hour course or a one-day 8 hour refresher course. Both courses include the following objectives:

- Erosion and sedimentation processes,
- Regulatory requirements,
- Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans,
- Best Management Practices,
- Inspections,
- Record-keeping, and
- Cold climate challenges.

To become certified, an individual must attend the entire course and pass a written exam. The certification is valid for three years. The program is administered by a collaboration of government agencies and contractor associations to provide standardized training statewide.
